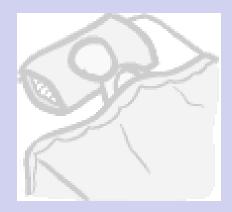


When Going to Bed Say:

أمُوُتُ وَ أَحْيِلَى

Bismika Allahumma amutu wa ahya

In Your Name, Oh Allah, I die and live.



Narrated by Hudhaifa (radi Allahu anhu): Whenever the Prophet (salla Allahu alayhi wa sallam) intended to go to bed, he would recite: "<u>Bismika</u> <u>Allahumma amutu wa ahya</u> (With Your name, O Allah, I die and I live)." And when he woke up from his sleep, he would say: "Al-hamdu lil-lahil-ladhi ahyana ba'da ma amatana; wa ilaihi an-nushur (All the Praises are for Allah Who has made us alive after He made us die (sleep) and unto Him is the Resurrection)."
