


TYPES OF MADDOOD

Natural Madd

Natural Madd



2 counts

Caused / followed by a (ء) Hamza

Waajib Mutasil

A letter of madd followed by a hamza in the same word. Elongated 4,5, 6 counts

Jaa'iz Munfasil

A letter of madd followed by a hamza in the next word. Elongated 4,5, 6 counts

Natural Madd

Caused / followed by a ـــــــــ sukoon

Laazim

Caused/followed by an original ـــــــــ sukoon after a madd letter, elongated 6 counts

'Aarid Li Sukoon

Caused/followed by a ـــــــــ sukoon that is not original to the word but is caused by a stop and occurs after a madd letter. Elongated 2, 4, 6 counts

Harfee

A ـــــــــ sukoon that occurs after a madd letter in the spelling of the letter

Heavy

A 3 letter spelling – the final letter blends with a letter that follows

Light

A 3 letter spelling – the final letter does not blend with a letter that follows it

Kalimee

A ـــــــــ sukoon that occurs after a madd letter in a word

Heavy

A madd letter followed by a letter with a ـــــــــ shaddah

Light

A madd letter followed by a letter with a ـــــــــ sukoon

BRANCHES OF MADD

Madd Sila

Major

Madd directed by the masculine pronoun 'ha' (هـ) that falls between 2 letters that have a harakat. The following letter has a hamza (أ).

Elongated 2, 4 or 5 counts

Minor

Madd directed by the masculine pronoun 'ha' (هـ) that falls between 2 letters that have a harakat. The following letter is not a hamza (أ).

Elongated 2 counts

Madd 'Ewad

A Madd that occurs only upon stopping at a word that has an alif with a tanween (أً).

Elongated 2 counts

Madd Leen

Occurs in the case of



And the letter following it has a sukoon as a result of stopping. Elongated 2, 4 or 6 counts

Madd Badal

A hamza that precedes a Madd letter in one word.

Elongated 2 counts
